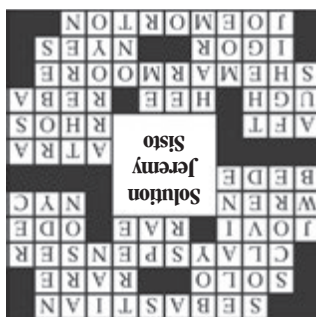

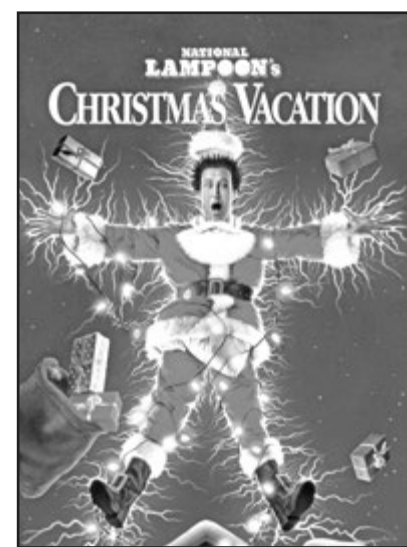

While Clark is in bed with his sap-covered "sticky" fingers trying to read People Magazine, the person featured on the cover is none other than the film's director, Jeremiah S. Chechik. This also marked Chechik's first-ever feature film.

Cousin Eddie (Randy Quaid) reappeared in his own 2003 NBC made-for-TV movie, "Christmas Vacation 2: Cousin Eddie's Island Adventure." Miriam Flynn reprised her role as Catherine, which found the family shipwrecked on a Pacific Island. Unfortunately, the ratings among viewers totally sank.

Let's not forget about Aunt Bethany, played by Mae Questel. Though her cat-wrapped lines were few, they sure continue to bring plenty of laughs. This was Questel's last film ever made. Her other notable work includes providing the voices of Betty Boop and Olive Oyl. "Play ball!"

## Comic Abby McEnany is a 'Work in Progress' in new Showtime series

If Abby McEnany is a "Work in Progress," she's about to share that information with a lot of people.

Along with filmmaker Tim Mason, the Chicago-based improv performer is the creator and executive producer of the new

comedy series that Showtime acquired after its independently made pilot debuted at this year's Sundance Film Festival. Premiering Sunday, Dec. 8, the show also stars McEnany as a fictionalized version of herself, a person who has a hard time finding her place in the world — until her sister (Karin Anglin) matches her with a transgender man (Theo Germaine) who has an unexpectedly beneficial influence on her.

McEnany describes herself as "somebody who is basically that mess you see in (the show). Comedy during really hard things has helped me survive, I guess. I think we always wanted to just tell the truth." Still, she admits some of that "truth" is embellished for the sake of the brand of humor she delivers: "A lot of people were like, 'Did your therapist really die?' I'm like, 'Are you kidding? I wouldn't be here. I would lose it.'"

Lilly Wachowski — of "The Matrix" moviemaking fame — also is an executive producer and writer of "Work in Progress,"

which involves "Saturday Night Live" alum Julia Sweeney and her androgynous Pat character to a notable degree. (Sweeney does appear in the show.)

"Pat ruined my life," McEnany maintains. "I've been called 'Pat' a lot, and (in) the storytelling show that this kind of came out of, one of the stories is called 'Julia Sweeney Ruined My Life.' It's not really about the character. It's about society, and (that) people feel that they can take things — characters or art or whatever — and choose those as forms of bigotry and harassment.

"And it wasn't just those fratty guys that we see in the pilot," adds McEnany. "I was called 'Pat' by lesbians in lesbian bars, so it just permeated even what I thought would be a safe space. Julia Sweeney ... she is so talented, and I would hear her storytelling on 'This American Life,' and I am enamored and in awe of her. But Pat was really rough."

McEnany still marvels that "Work in Progress" has found a home at Showtime, since she and Mason weren't sure what they'd do with their pilot. She recalls, "When Sundance said 'Yes,' it was like, 'What are you talking about?' I just lost it. And then, after the premiere, we met (Showtime programming executive) Dave Binegar, and he gave me his card. I'm like, 'Why are you giving me your card? I can't call you. You're from Showtime.' Anyways, it's been bonkers. And it is still unbelievable."

## TV PIPELINE

**Q:** Has "Days of Our Lives" been canceled? — Sheila Morris, via e-mail

**A:** Much has been said about this in recent weeks, and here's the story. NBC has not canceled the venerable daytime serial (or at least hadn't at the time this was written), but the company that makes the drama — Corday Productions — terminated its contracts with all of the actors. That doesn't necessarily say much for loyalty, considering how long some of those performers have been with the show, but it surely was a canny business move.

What this means is that if the show is picked up again, the actors will have to agree to new contracts (possibly for less pay) to continue in their roles. Production is done well ahead of the airing of the episodes, and enough "Days" has been made to take it up to the start of NBC's coverage of the 2020 Summer Olympics in July. For "Days" to resume telecasts on the other side of that, work would have to start up again fairly soon, so the future of the drama and its stars should become known before long. In the meantime, it certainly has made for lots of conversation, particularly among those who literally have grown up watching the show. Some of the performers also have spoken out about the situation, including Chrishell Hartley (wife of "This Is Us" co-star Justin Hartley), who is advising fans to watch the series "live" when it airs weekdays — and not later, via recordings of it — to demonstrate to NBC and the producers that devotees still want their "Days."

**Q:** When is "Criminal Minds" coming back? — Matt Draper, via e-mail

**A:** There's finally a start date for the 15th and last season of the CBS crime drama ... Jan. 8, which will see a two-hour episode launch the rather compacted final round. The show also will conclude with a two-hour story on Feb. 19, and since the series has been delving more and more into the personal lives of its characters, expect big developments on that front for David Rossi (played by Joe Mantegna) and others before the program's ultimate sign-off.

**Q:** Was the 1960s "Batman" movie made before the television series? — Jim Grace, Flagler Beach, Fla.

**A:** No, but the timing was close. The movie was made in 1966, between production of the first and second seasons of the ABC series; in fact, the picture was in theaters barely two months after the cam-

eras stopped rolling on it. Producer William Dozier had wanted to make the movie as the pilot for the series, but it was only after the show became a hit that he got the go-ahead for the longer version.

Among interesting bits of trivia: Star Adam West wanted more money for doing the movie, but (at least according to his autobiography) he was threatened with being replaced with another actor if he didn't capitulate; Julie Newmar couldn't appear in the picture as Catwoman because of another acting commitment she'd already made (thus, the casting of Lee Meriwether as the villainess); and some footage from the film, particularly scenes of the Batboat and the Batcopter in motion, was repurposed for later episodes of the series.

## RECOGNIZING COURAGE

A few weeks ago, I had the honor of attending the ceremony in which Middtown Community School was named in honor of Sergeant William Shemin. He was a Bayonne resident who was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor posthumously in 2015 for his bravery during World War I.

Before going off to war, William Shemin worked as Assistant Forester for the City of Bayonne. The future soldier lived for a while on East 40th Street. He registered for the draft on June 5, 1917. The Army shipped him to the war from Hoboken on May 10, 1918. On August 7, 8, and 9, 1918, Sergeant Shemin exhibited extraordinary courage in action on the Vesle River, near Bazoches, France. In the citation for his Distinguished Service Cross, the text states that, on three different occasions, Sergeant Shemin "crossed an open space of 150 yards, exposed to heavy machine gun fire to rescue the wounded. After officers and senior non-commissioned officers had become casualties, Sergeant Shemin took command of the platoon and displayed great initiative under fire until wounded August 9."

Sergeant Shemin was wounded by shrapnel. Later, he was hit in the head with a machine gun bullet. He was hospitalized for three months, and received a Distinguished Service Cross and a Purple

Heart. He was discharged from the Army in 1919. Mr. Shemin arrived back from Europe in Hoboken on July 27, 1919. As a civilian, William Shemin earned a degree from the New York State College of Forestry. He opened a greenhouse and landscaping business in New York. Mr. Shemin and his wife, Bertha, raised three children. He died in 1973, and is buried on Staten Island.



At the recent ceremony, the school showed a video from 2015, when President Barack Obama presented the Congressional Medal of Honor to the Shemin family. Several family members were present for the program at William Shemin Middtown Community School.

I would like to thank the Bayonne Board of Education for naming Middtown School in Sergeant Shemin's honor. It was the right thing for our country and our community to recognize his acts of life-saving heroism during World War I. In Bayonne, we are proud that three of our residents have received the Congressional Medal of Honor: Stephen R. Gregg and Nicholas Oresko for their extraordinary bravery in World War II, and William Shemin for his extraordinary courage in World War I.

**Fine-tune your holiday menu with ideas from Food Network and Cooking Channel**

By now, you're probably knee-deep in menu ideas for your holiday party. At least, we hope so. If not and you find yourself at a loss for what to make, look no further than Food Network and Cooking Channel for suggestions that will keep your guests clamoring for more and put your bash on everyone's must-attend list for December to come. If that's what

you really want. Among them are an Asian braised beef that is slow cooked and served over rice, a cheesy tomato soup with croutons and a black bean soup. Also, she makes her 10-minute "chicken curry in a hurry," prepared in 10 minutes. Then on "Trisha's Southern Kitchen," Trisha Yearwood goes to Nashville to meet with a friend and gather ingredients for a warm, comforting meal consisting of a tea-poached pear and goat cheese galette, mushroom and butternut squash risotto, a flavorful spice-rubbed roast chicken and for dessert, dark chocolate chai cookies. Yum. If you're getting a bit of wanderlust, Cooking Channel's Monday, Dec. 9, holiday-themed episode of "The Best Thing I Ever Ate" brings Brad Miller to Wilmington, Del., for a holiday steak, Andrew Zimmern to New York City for dim sum and Georey Zakarian to Mystic, Conn., for baked goods.

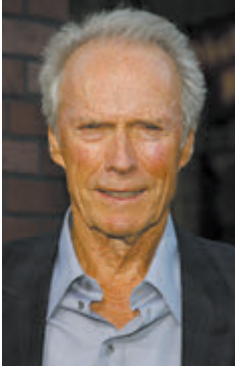

**HOLLYWOOD** — When "Avengers: Endgame" became the top-grossing film of all time, it showed old Hollywood how movie-going tastes have changed. Detractors consider "Endgame" merely a comic book movie, but Stephen McFeely, who co-wrote "Endgame" with Christopher Markus, asks, "Is 'The Silence of the Lambs' just a serial-killer movie, or 'Annie Hall' just a romantic comedy and 'The Godfather' a mob movie?" Martin Scorsese and Francis Ford Coppola have been speaking out in opposition to big-budget comic book cinema. Scorsese admitted, "I don't see them. I tried, you know? But that's not cinema. It isn't the cinema of human beings trying to convey emotional, psychological experiences to another human being. It's something else, we shouldn't be invaded by it." He called on theater owners to "step up" to prevent Marvel movies from pushing narrative films out of theaters. Coppola, while accepting an award in Italy, defended Scorsese's argument, "He's right because we expect to learn something from cinema, get enlightenment, knowledge and inspiration. Martin was being kind when he said 'It's not cinema.' He didn't say it's despicable, which I just say it is." The other side has fired back, Markus defended his film with, "Not to pat ourselves on the back, but we snuck an hourlong movie

about loss and grief into the biggest movie of all time." Taika Waititi, a writer/director for the Marvel Cinematic Universe added: "It's kind of a form of ignorance to say comic-book and graphic novels aren't art. They have life-changing stories of emotion, they're cinematic. No one is comparing 'Antman' to 'Citizen Kane,' however, as 'Doctor Strange' director Scott Derrickson tweeted, 'Nobody should dismiss movies they haven't seen!' The times they are a changing!"

Clint Eastwood has starred in 53 films, produced 36 films and just completed directing his 39th film, "Richard Jewell." It's about the security guard who saved lives at the bombing of the Centennial Olympic Park at the 1996 Olympics in Atlanta only to become a suspect himself. Eastwood turns 90 in May and is showing no signs of slowing down. Clint's son, Scott, has a ways to go to catch up to his dad, having just completed his 28th film (since 2006), "The Manuscript," directed by Nick Cassavetes and starring Jamie Foxx and Jean Reno, for a Jan. 1 release.

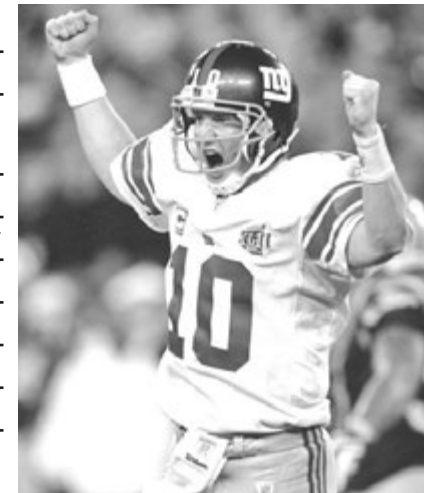
